Summary

The neck midline cystis is the most common congenital malformation in the neck area. In described case of 33 years women the diagnosis was established on clinical examination, the results of USG and the aspiration biopsy. The tumor was surgically excised and the microscopy examination revealed papillary cystic carcinoma of ectopic thyroid gland in glossothyroid ductus. In the every case of neck tumor we have to consider neoplastic process.
