Plasmocytoma of the larynx

Summary

Multiple myeloma is a neoplasmatological proliferation of the plasma cells of clonal character producing similar immunoglobulins or part of the immunoglobulins. Multiple myeloma occasionally occurs as plasmocytoma solitäre extramedulläre. The location of plasmocytoma in the larynx is extremely rare. We are describing the case of the larynx plasmocytoma diagnosed for a 79 years old female patient. After histopathologic diagnosis of the laryngeal polyp the patient was examined hematologically in great detail aiming at the investigation of myeloma multiplex. No features of multiple myeloma have been found. Now the patient is under strict laryngological and hematological care.
